Who can apply?

- be willing to **take up frontline duties**, including cleaning and heavy lifting
- be suitable to **work outdoors** in a very hot environment and able to **stand for long hours**
- be willing to **share apartments** with other participants from other countries
- be cheerful, outgoing and enthusiastic
- have a flexible work attitude, hardworking and mature

Pay Rate

- **\$11.00usd per hour** - All roles are non-tipped
- Participants are guaranteed a minimum of 30 hours per week

J-1 Visa

Participants are responsible for:

- **Cost of US Embassy/Consulate appointment** (approximately \$190usd / 2020 cost to be confirmed)
- **SEVIS Fee to US Embassy/Consulate** (approximately \$35usd / 2020 cost to be confirmed)

Medical Insurance

- **Participants must obtain medical insurance** for the length of the program from **Lloyd's of London** (Details to follow)

Housing

- **Rent: \$108usd to \$200usd per week** (depends on the complex and size of the unit)
- **\$240usd Non-refundable Program Assessment Fee (one-time fee)**
- **\$150usd Housing Deposit to be paid at time of program acceptance**
- All complexes are gated with 24-hour security staff
- Participants will share a bedroom with at least one other person
- Transportation to and from work is provided
- Participants must provide own sheets, pillow, blanket and towels
- Participants must provide own food in apartment and at work

Airfare
